- 4 year-old class- Tues. & Thurs. OR Weds. & Fri. 9-2pm (Must be 4 by Sept. 1st.)

1 Child- \$165.00

2 Children- \$315.00

3 Children- \$465.00

\*Sibling discount is \$15.00 per additional student.

We accept cash, check or online bank draft pay. *Tuition is due monthly. Late tuition may result in a non-admit until balance is paid. Tuition is not discounted for vacation time. A two-week written notice is required for early withdrawal.*
